II. RESEARCH THEME

The concept of "social representation" is central in psychology and more particularly in the field of social psychology. Jodelet (1991) defines social representation as a "sort of knowledge, commonly elaborated and shared by a society, aiming to build a common reality for a social group".

In my research, I try to underline the unavailability of such a theoretical approach characterized by a high degree of conceptualisation and, finally, by an *irrelevant* level of abstraction.

Research orientations :

1/ Development of an exploratory method aiming at :

- Defining "resonant properties" of certain significations given to the "world"
- Highlighting the "fragments" of lived experiences related to significations given to the "world".

2/ Development of a complex protocol of analyses in order to :

- Describe the homogeneity and the heterogeneity of the fields of significance
- Reveal the convergence and divergence phenomena of given proprieties related to the fields of significance
- Create an index of resonance allowing to discriminate experiential densities

3/ Development of an alternative theoretical approach which takes as a starting point the ego ecological model (Zavalloni & Louis-Guérin, 1984), the phenomenology (Husserl) and the enactive project (Varela)
